FREEZE YOUR CREDIT Freezing your credit is permanent until you lift the freeze. This helps prevent con artists from getting your credit report and applying for credit in your name without your knowledge. It does not affect your credit rating. If you need to apply for credit, you will have to lift the freeze first, apply, then re-freeze. You must freeze at all of the agencies below.
